Ag Facts from Food and Farm Facts*:

- **One US Farm feeds 166 people.** Of those 166 people, 106 are in the United States and 60 are international.
- Farm and ranch families make up less than 2% of the US Population.
- **US consumers spend** approximately 10% of their disposable income on their food.
- **The global population** is expected to increase by 2.2 billion by 2050, which means the world's farmers will have to grow about 70% more food than what is now produced.
- America's most grown-commodity is grain, at 965.2 billion pounds of Corn, Wheat, Oats, Rice, Barley, Rye, & Sorghum.
- Women make up 36% of American farm operators.
- **About 27% of farmers** are beginning farmers, and their average age of all farmers is 46 years old.
- **Today, 97 percent of all U.S. farms** are owned by individuals, family partnerships or family corporations. Just three percent of America's farms and ranches are owned by non-family corporations or other entities.
- Only 15% of your food dollar you spend goes back to the farm.
- An acre is around the size of a football field.
- You can grow around 50,000 pounds of strawberries on one acre.
- The National Food Stamp Act was passed in 1964.
